

## Lenham Parish Council – traffic speed summary

Lenham Parish Council operates the Speed Indicating Device which is moved around 3 locations in Lenham Village and 2 locations in Platts Heath. It spends up to 6 weeks at each location. The device records the date, time and speed of every vehicle approaching the Village / Hamlet within the 30 mph limit.

\* The 85 percentile is the average speed of 85% of the traffic and is the figure used by KCC Highways to compare locations to determine priorities. In principle within a 30mph limit it should not exceed 35 mph.
